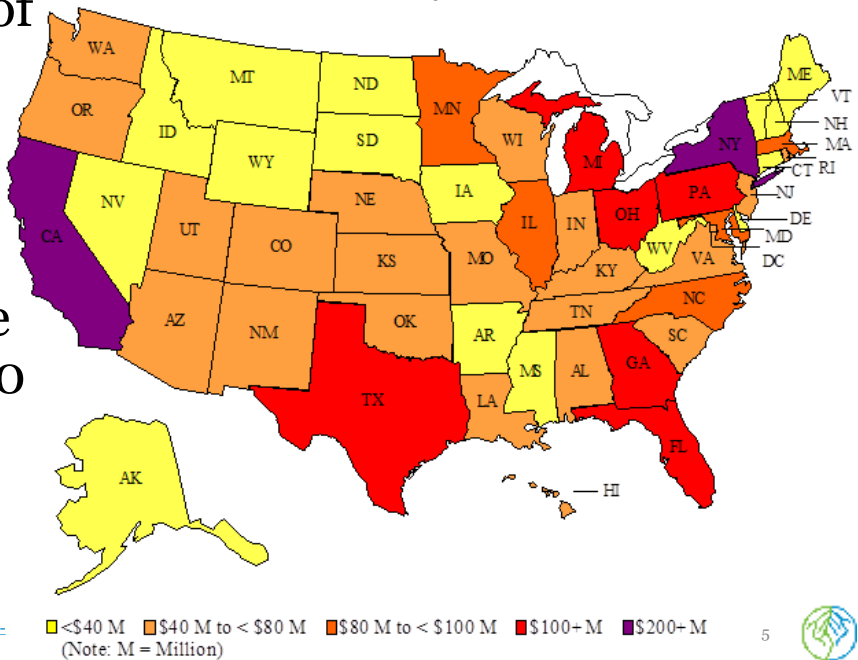

- › PPHF, part of ACA, is 12% of CDC budget
- › If repealed, Texas to lose \$147,214,850 over next 5 years

ANNUAL TEXAS IMPACT

- › Loss of \$26,442,970
- › Loss of 631 public health jobs
- › Loss of \$4,195,910 for low-income children and adult vaccine programs
- › Loss of \$6,166,855 to DSHS for core needs
- › Loss of \$998,540 for infectious disease prevention

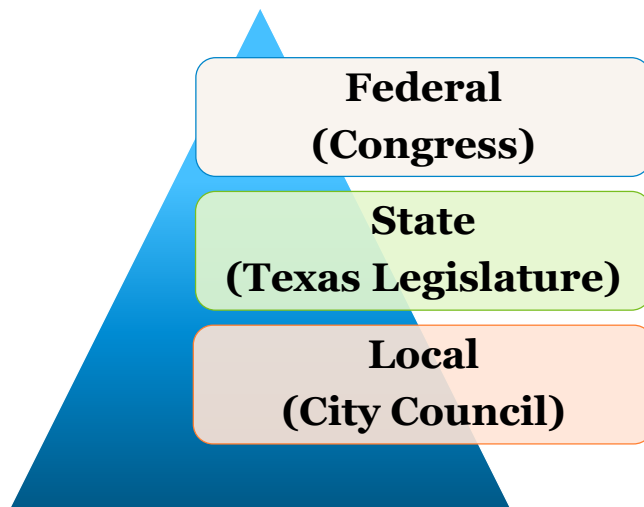

TEXAS LEGISLATURE

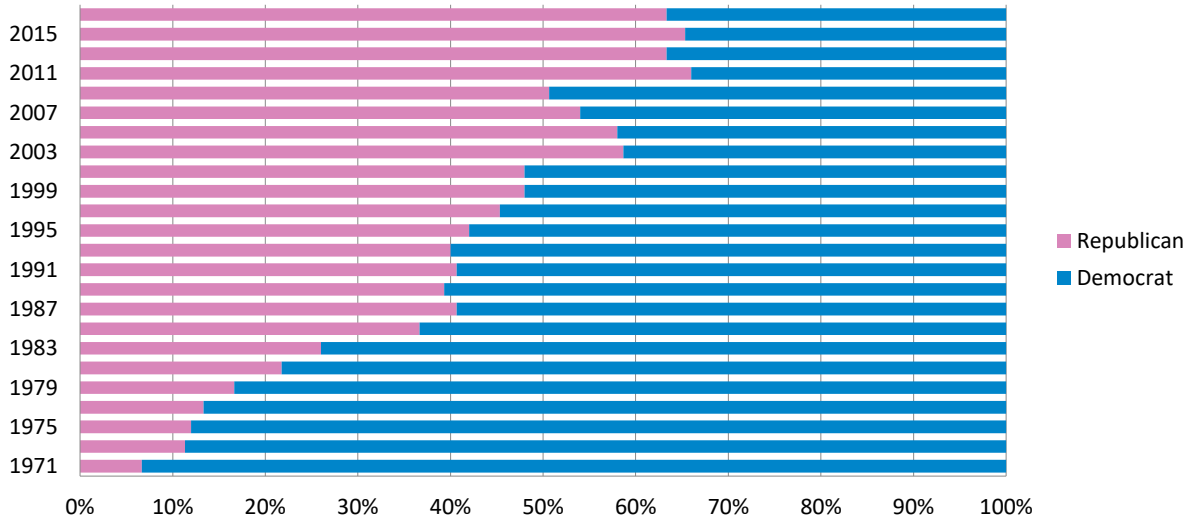


- > 150 members of Texas House of Representatives

TEXAS HOUSE

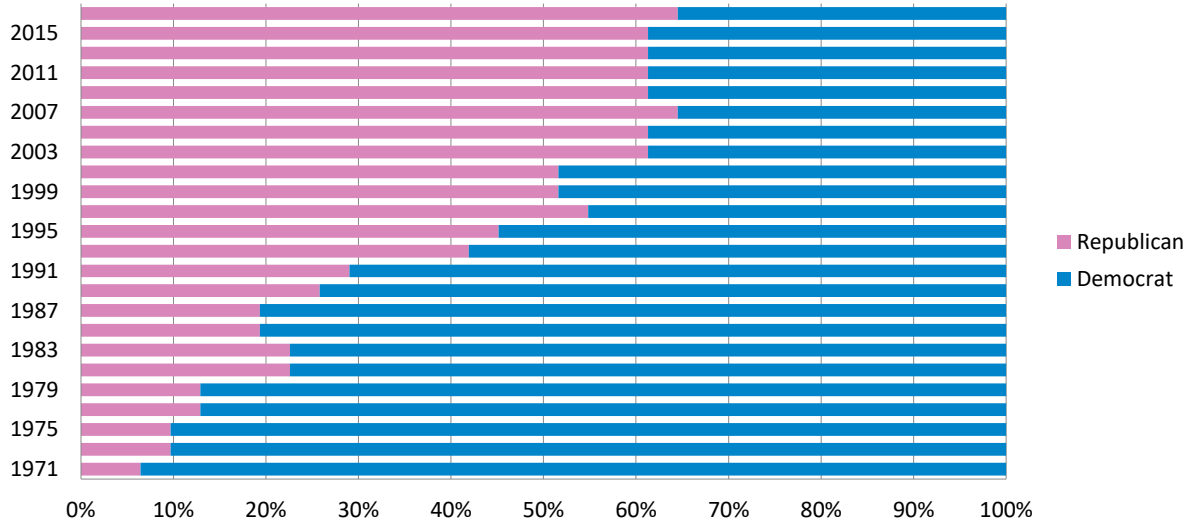

MEDICAL EXEMPTION BILL

Allow Advanced Practice RNs to sign medical exemption affidavits (in addition to physicians)

Require providers to print risks from Vaccine Information Statement and Vaccine Excipient & Media Summary

Health care provider cannot “fire” patient over immunization status

- › H.B. 1070 by Jeff Leach (R-TXH-67-Allen)

“Texas Health Care Right of Conscience Act”

- › H.B. 2878 by Scott Sanford (R-TXH-70-McKinney)
 - › No hearing in State Affairs Cmte

FEEL-GOOD BILL

Recognizing the important role of vaccinations in preventing meningococcal disease

- › H.C.R. 64 by Chris Turner (D-TXH-101-Grand Prairie)
 - › Passed Public Health Cmte, no floor vote

FOSTER CARE BILL

Foster child in care of DFPS no longer allowed to be immunized during medical exam, except for emergency tetanus

- › Floor amendment by Bill Zedler (R-TXH-96-Arlington) to H.B. 39 by Gene Wu (D-TXH-137-Houston)
 - › **Passed House**
